GENEVA, 9 December 2022 — The PH Mission and Consulate General joined Foreign Service posts worldwide in the resumption of the continuing registration for overseas voting on December 9, 2022 pursuant to Comelec Resolution No. 10833 dated 7 September 2022. Registration will be from 9 December 2022 to 30 September 2024.

Consul Luningning Camoying Valdez of the PH Mission was the first registrant enrolled by the Consulate General in Geneva.

New registrants who qualify, as well as existing voters, are eligible to vote in the Philippine 2025 midterm elections, the 2028 National elections and subsequent elections.

Early registration of interested parties is highly encouraged.
